Presents: Washington Adventist Hospital

Background:

In April 2018, both the City and representatives of Holy Cross Hospital sent letters to the Maryland Healthcare Commission in response to Adventist HealthCare's request to change their previously approved project and request an exemption from the Certificate of Need process. The request from Adventist HealthCare came as a great surprise in light of the previous (2015) Certificate of Need decision by the Commission. Copies of the letters are available below.

• Washington Adventist Hospital Questions and Answers (March 19, 2018)

As part of the relocation of Washington Adventist Hospital's main hospital to White Oak in Silver Spring, the hospital is required to maintain an urgent care facility at the Takoma Park campus, to be operated every day, 24 hours per day, beginning as soon as the hospital move takes place. The City and community has advocated for a Freestanding Medical Facility (stand-alone emergency department) on the Takoma Park campus. While Washington Adventist Hospital pledged to seriously consider requesting authorization to establish such a facility once State regulations were finalized, they have since determined that a freestanding medical facility is not financially feasible.
